


# LAVA FLOWS, VOLCANOES, CLOUD FORESTS & MORE

From the cloud forest on the Chyulu Hills, semi arid scrub, volcanic lava fields, Jurassic age granite monoliths, the cliffs of the Yatta plateau, wildlife attractions including the largest population of red elephants in East Africa, over 500 bird species and some of the best views of Mt. Kilimanjaro's peaks, one can spend days and days and barely scratch the surface of what Tsavo has to offer.

# THE CHYULU'S

The Chyulu Hills are the youngest volcanic range of hills in the world and as Ernst Hemingway aptly called them- "The Green hills of Africa"

Verdant rolling hills of endless green, great blue skies, spectacular landscape views and fauna including buffaloes, elands, elephants, leopards, reedbucks and giraffes along with various reptiles and insects are what the Chyulu Hills provide to nature lovers. Mountain climbing and bird watching can be enjoyed in this hidden part of paradise, not to mention the incredible cloud forests.

## **CHYULU SUNRISE**

The 4am wake up call will be well worth this incredible experience. You will find yourself above the immense Chyulu Cloud forests which make way for the most spectacular sunrise.

# **HIKES & WALKS**

Our walking safaris take in some of the world's most spectacular natural scenery. Our trips combine some of the finest natural backdrops with a rich slice of local history and culture.

### **CAMP SAFARI WALK**

This is a good opportunity to see the birds and smaller creatures around camp. The guide will explain the medicinal value of trees and plants, how to recognize animal footprints and interesting facts on insects as well. Please speak to the front office to organize the bush walk

A great way to get some exercise, but you must be reasonably fit to enjoy this experience. Once you complete the 1 hour climb of Oldoinyo Ololarami dormant volcano, the views of Tsavo that are enjoyed are breathtaking.

# **GAME DRIVES**

The best time to spot wildlife in Tsavo is in the early hours of morning and in the late afternoon. We offer two scheduled game drives at these times but can of course cater to your timings.

The beauty of Finch Hattons is that you also do not have to leave the camp to feel immersed in the wild. Simply relax at the camp, let go of the modern world and spot a wide variety of animals including hippos, terrapins, crocodiles and baboons. Get connected with nature.

### **NIGHT GAME DRIVES**

This gives you the opportunity to explore the nocturnal wildlife in Tsavo, which include leopards, civet cats, genet cats and bush babies. Another exciting aspect of the night game drive is experiencing the night sounds and starlit sky. The ideal time is between 5pm to 9pm or 7.45pm to 11pm.

# **EXCURSIONS**

#### SHETANI LAVA FLOW

Some 200 years ago, a stream of fiery magma erupted from the nearby Chyulu Hills. 'Shetani' means devil in Kiswahili, named by the local community as they believed that it was the devil himself emerging from the earth. This vast expanse of folded black lava provides a spectacular view.

### **MZIMA SPRINGS**

A beautiful oasis of natural springs

Mzima, meaning "alive" is fed by four natural subterranean streams that rise on the slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro, Mzima is a wonderful place to observe the wildlife that lives within. The underwater observation chamber provides an opportunity to watch the circling shoals of carp-like fish, and if you are there at the right time you may get a glimpse of one of the hippos that frequent the pools.

NGULIA RHINO SANCTUARY

Home to about 80 endangered Black Rhino, the sanctuary is one of the most important Rhino conservation projects in East Africa with 18% of Kenya's Black Rhino found within this highly protected area.

The best time to visit is between 4pm to 6pm

Charge: \$350 per vehicle.

**Duration:** 5 hours (Depart camp at 2pm)

#### POACHERS LOOK-OUT

Nestled on the top of one of the hills in Tsavo is a small rush-roofed hut that was used in the past by KWS rangers to fight poachers. Used now as a wonderful viewing plateau, you can enjoy 360-degree views of the plains and spectacular views of Mt. Kilimanjaro.

#### ROARING ROCKS

This provides magnificent views over Rhino valley. The area is named after the buzz of cicadas that inhabit them and the howl of wind that hits the bare rocks by producing a roaring sound.

Charge: \$350 per excursion per vehicle. Maximum 6 pax

# LAKE JIPE

Lake Jipe is a shallow lake set on the remote southern border of Tsavo West. A hidden gem for bird lovers, look out for the pygmy goose, black egret and black coucal.

Charge: \$650 per excursion per vehicle. Maximum 6 pax

### CHAIMU CRATER

Rising in stark isolation from the wooded plains of Tsavo West, this conical pyramid is actually a dormant volcano. Take a one-hour trek to the top of the crater to enjoy the fantastic views.

Charge: \$75 per person. Minimum 2 pax
